The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) invites you to participate in public events to review revised improvement alternatives for the **US 30 Bypass Western Terminus/Route 10 Project Area in Sadsbury and West Sadsbury Townships in Chester County**. The Western Terminus/Route 10 Project Area (Section 10) is one of a series of projects that will upgrade and reconstruct the US 30 Bypass in Chester County.
